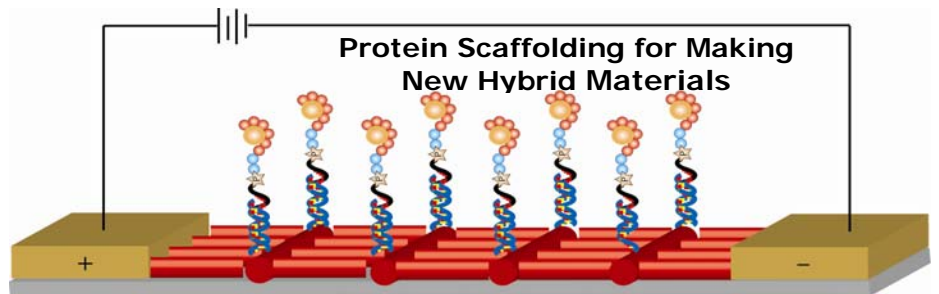


Evolution on a Chip: Making Molecules Work for Us
