


# NHTSA mandated "Warning Label" 1996





### DEATH or SERIOUS INJURY can occur

- · Children 12 and under can be killed by the air bag
- The BACK SEAT is the SAFEST place for children
- NEVER put a rear-facing child seat in the front
- · Sit as far back as possible from the air bag
- ALWAYS use SEAT BELTS and CHILD RESTRAINTS



- The back seat is the safest place for children of any age to ride.
- Never put an infant (less than one year old) in the front of a car with a passenger-side air bag.
- Infants must always ride in the back seat facing the rear of the car.
- Make sure everyone is buckled up. Unbuckled occupants can be hurt or killed by an air bag.



Infant Restraints (1-12 months): 85% to 93%




# NHTSA Counts for Air Bag Fatalities (1990-2000)

### A smart parent still beats a smart airbag.

- **Tip #1:** Multi-stage airbags can still injure children! Keep infants and small children in the back seat, buckled into child seats or safety belts.
- **Tip #2:** Drivers and front-seat passengers should always buckle up, slide the seat back to a comfortable position, and avoid sitting or leaning close to the air bag.
- **Tip #3:** If your vehicle has an air bag on/off switch, check to make sure it is set properly on each trip for the occupant in that seat.
- **Tip #4:** To reduce the risk of injury, put 10-inches between your chest and the air bag cover.
- **Tip #5:** Never place your feet on the dashboard, which contains the airbag.
- Tip #6: Adult passengers should sit straight and stay buckled.

### **A WARNING**

#### EVEN WITH ADVANCED AIR BAGS



- Children can be killed or seriously injured by the air bag
- The back seat is the safest place for children
- Never put a rear-facing child seat in the front
- Always use seat belts and child restraints
